February 2001

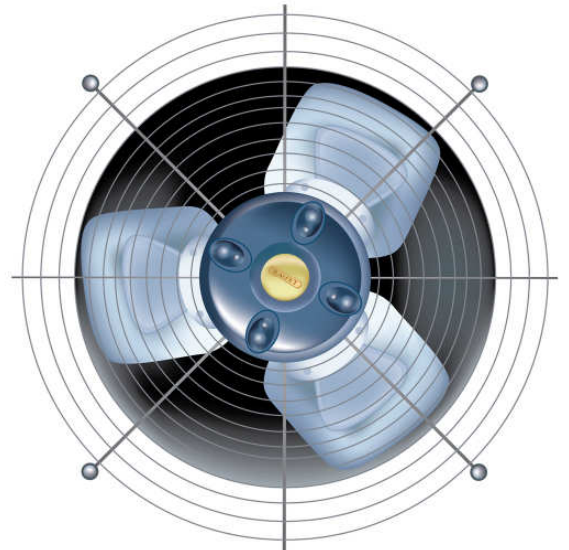
