The New Mexico Chapter presented two Science Fair Awards to students from Jefferson Middle School and Saint Pius X High School.

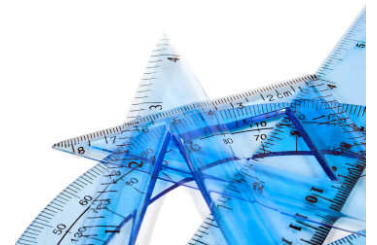
John Grapsas, Research Promotion Chairman, had collected \$7,425.00 by the publication date of the Thin-Air Bulletin.
